- WHAT kind of biblical writing is John?
 - Poetry/hymn (John 1: 1-18), Narrative, eye-witness (rest of John)
- WHY did John write?
 - o "ÁlbaeSe d'aró vớr i thà k thà trọc u Pm Pypb @ i Pve tha de de sha is the the son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name" (John 20: 31)
 - The word "believe" is used 98 times in the gospel of John- always as a verb! Belief is an action that leads to abundant, embodied, eternal life...
 - o Wants his readers to understand Jesus AS God incarnate- "The deeds and works of Jesus are the doe ds and works of Jesus are the doe ds and works of Jesus are the doe ds and works of Jesus are
- WHEN was John written?
 - Usually dated between 70-130 CE
- HOW is/nlehm otkechused? 5 parts!
 - Part ONE (John 1): Introduction of Jesus
 - o Part TWO (John 2-12): Miraculous signs
 - o Part THREE (John 13-17) Night before Jesus trial/final words to disciples
